Terms and Conditions:

Clause 1 – Engagement

Production Company hereby engages Crew Member and Crew Member accepts engagement as an independent contractor to perform services related to the film production project identified above under the terms herein.

Clause 2 – Independent Contractor Status

Crew Member is retained as an independent contractor and not as an employee, partner, or agent of Production Company. Crew Member shall have no claim against Production Company hereunder or otherwise for vacation pay, sick leave, retirement benefits, social security, worker's compensation, health or disability benefits, unemployment insurance benefits, or employee benefits of any kind.

Clause 3 – Services

Crew Member agrees to provide professional services consistent with the role and responsibilities outlined above and cooperate fully with Production Company and other personnel.

Clause 4 – Term

The engagement shall continue for the duration mutually agreed upon by the parties or until earlier terminated in accordance with this Agreement.

Clause 5 – Compensation

Production Company shall pay Crew Member the agreed compensation as specified above, less any lawful deductions and withholdings.

Clause 6 – Expenses

Crew Member shall be responsible for all expenses incurred unless otherwise authorized in writing by Production Company.

Clause 7 – Confidentiality

Crew Member agrees to maintain the confidentiality of any confidential or proprietary information disclosed during the term of this Agreement.

Clause 8 – Intellectual Property

All work product, including but not limited to footage, recordings, scripts, and materials produced by Crew Member during engagement, shall be considered work made for hire and the exclusive property of Production Company.

Clause 9 – Compliance with Laws and Policies

Crew Member shall comply with all applicable laws, regulations, and Production Company's policies and procedures.

Clause 10 – Safety and Conduct

Crew Member shall adhere to all safety requirements and behave professionally and respectfully on set and at all related locations.

Clause 11 – Termination

Either party may terminate this Agreement upon written notice. Production Company may terminate immediately for cause including breach of contract, misconduct, or failure to perform.

Clause 12 – Indemnification

Crew Member shall indemnify and hold harmless Production Company from any claims, damages, liabilities, or expenses arising from Crew Member's acts or omissions.

Clause 13 – Insurance

Crew Member shall maintain appropriate insurance coverage as required by law and as reasonably requested by Production Company.

Clause 14 – Non-Assignment

Crew Member shall not assign or subcontract any obligation under this Agreement without prior written consent of Production Company.

Clause 15 – Governing Law and Venue

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the United States and the State where the principal place of business of Production Company is located. Venue for any disputes shall be in the appropriate state or federal courts located therein.

Clause 16 – Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations, or agreements, either written or oral.

Clause 17 – Amendments

Any modifications or amendments to this Agreement shall be in writing and signed by both parties.

Clause 18 – Severability

If any provision of this Agreement is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder shall continue in full force and effect.

Clause 19 – Waiver

Failure to enforce any provision shall not constitute a waiver of future enforcement of that or any other provision.

Clause 20 – Counterparts

This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which together shall constitute one instrument.
