Terms and Conditions:

Clause 1 – Scope of Services

Service Provider agrees to perform lawn care services as described above at the Client's property located at the address provided. Services will be performed in a professional, diligent, and workmanlike manner.

Clause 2 – Term

This Contract shall remain in effect until terminated by either party with a written notice delivered at least seven (7) days prior to termination.

Clause 3 – Payment

Client agrees to pay the Service Price as indicated above, according to the payment due date and method specified. Late payments may incur a late fee of 5% per month on the outstanding balance.

Clause 4 – Equipment and Materials

Service Provider shall supply all necessary equipment and materials to perform the services, except any special requests specifically stated in this Contract.

Clause 5 – Access and Safety

Client shall provide safe access to the property and notify Service Provider of any hazards or restrictions. Service Provider is not responsible for damage caused by hidden or unknown hazards.

Clause 6 – Liability and Indemnification

Service Provider shall maintain appropriate liability insurance. Client agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Service Provider from any claims, damages, or losses arising from Client's property conditions or actions.

Clause 7 – Cancellation and Rescheduling

Either party may cancel or reschedule a service with at least 24 hours' notice. Failure to provide notice may result in a service charge.

Clause 8 – Weather and Force Majeure

Service Provider shall not be liable for delays or non-performance due to weather, natural disasters, or other events beyond reasonable control.

Clause 9 – Dispute Resolution

The parties agree to attempt to resolve any disputes amicably before pursuing legal remedies. Any legal action shall be brought in a court of competent jurisdiction located within the United States.

Clause 10 – Governing Law

This Contract shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of _____.

Clause 11 – Entire Agreement

This Contract constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior agreements or understandings, written or oral, regarding the subject matter herein.

Clause 12 – Amendments

Any amendments or modifications to this Contract must be in writing and signed by both parties.

Clause 13 – Severability

If any provision of this Contract is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Clause 14 – Notices

All notices required or permitted under this Contract shall be in writing and delivered personally, by certified mail, or by a nationally recognized overnight courier to the addresses specified above.

Clause 15 – Independent Contractor

Service Provider is an independent contractor and not an employee of the Client. Nothing in this Contract shall be construed to create a partnership, joint venture, or employer-employee relationship.

Clause 16 – Insurance

Service Provider shall maintain general liability insurance in an amount adequate to cover risks associated with the services performed.

Clause 17 – Confidentiality

Both parties agree to keep confidential any proprietary information obtained during the course of this Contract.

Clause 18 – Non-Waiver

Failure by either party to enforce any provision of this Contract shall not be construed as a waiver of that provision or any other provision.

Clause 19 – Assignment

Neither party may assign or transfer this Contract or any rights hereunder without prior written consent of the other party.

Clause 20 – Signatures; Counterparts

This Contract may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of which together constitute one agreement.
