Terms and Conditions:

1. Scope of Services

Contractor agrees to provide snow removal services ('Services') at the Service Address described above, including but not limited to plowing, pushing, shoveling, and removal of snow accumulations as specified herein.

2. Service Schedule

Services shall be performed per push basis upon mutual agreement or request by Client. Contractor will make reasonable efforts to perform Services promptly after each snow event, but exact timing cannot be guaranteed.

3. Access and Safety

Client shall provide safe and reasonable access to the Service Address. Contractor is not responsible for damage resulting from hidden or unmarked obstacles, underground utilities, sprinkler heads, landscaping, or any other conditions not visible at the time of service.

4. Equipment

Contractor will use appropriate equipment and qualified personnel for the Services. Contractor reserves the right to subcontract Services to qualified providers if necessary.

5. Payment Terms

Client agrees to pay Contractor the Price per Push multiplied by the actual number of Services performed. Payment shall be due within 15 days of invoice receipt unless otherwise agreed in writing.

6. Term and Termination

This Contract shall remain in effect until terminated by either party with written notice. Termination does not relieve Client of payment obligations for Services already performed.

7. Liability and Indemnification

Contractor shall maintain general liability insurance covering the Services. Client agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Contractor from claims arising out of Client's negligence or failure to disclose pertinent property conditions.

8. Weather and Force Majeure

Contractor shall not be liable for delays or failure to perform due to weather conditions, acts of God, government restrictions, or other circumstances beyond Contractor's control.

9. Governing Law

This Contract shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the United States and the State where the Service Address is located, without regard to conflict of law rules.

10. Entire Agreement

This Contract constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior negotiations and agreements. Any modifications must be in writing and signed by both parties.

11. Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising under this Contract shall be resolved first through good faith negotiations. If unresolved, disputes may be submitted to mediation or arbitration in accordance with applicable law.

12. No Waiver

Failure by either party to enforce any provision shall not constitute a waiver of future enforcement of that or any other provision.

13. Severability

If any provision is found unenforceable, the remainder shall continue in full force and effect.

14. Notices

All notices shall be in writing and delivered by hand, certified mail, or electronic means to the contact information provided herein.

15. Signatures

This Contract may be executed in counterparts. Signatures provided by electronic means shall be deemed original and legally binding.
