

SOCIAL CONTRACT

Introduction:

This Social Contract (the “Contract”) is entered into by and between the undersigned parties (the “Parties”). The Parties hereby agree to the terms and conditions set forth herein to establish their mutual rights, duties, and responsibilities in connection with their social and cooperative relationship, aiming to foster a harmonious, respectful, and legally compliant association under the laws of the United States.

Article 1 – Purpose and Scope:

The Parties agree to collaborate with mutual respect, honesty, and transparency, acknowledging the social, cultural, and legal frameworks that govern their interaction. This Contract governs the conduct, conflict resolution, and cooperation between the Parties and shall be deemed legally binding and enforceable.

Article 4 – Confidentiality and Data Protection:

The Parties acknowledge their obligation to protect any confidential or sensitive information accessed during their association. No Party shall disclose such information without prior written consent, except as required by law or legal process. All data handling shall comply with applicable federal and state privacy laws.

Article 5 – Dispute Resolution:

Any dispute arising out of or relating to this Contract shall be resolved through good faith negotiations between the Parties. Failing resolution, the Parties agree to submit the dispute to mediation by a neutral third party before pursuing any other legal remedies. This provision does not preclude any Party from seeking injunctive relief or other equitable remedies as necessary.

Article 6 – Termination:

This Contract may be terminated by mutual written agreement of the Parties or unilaterally by any Party upon written notice to the other Parties specifying the reasons for termination. Termination shall not affect accrued rights or

obligations. Provisions intended to survive termination shall remain in effect.

Article 7 – Amendments:

Any amendment or modification to this Contract shall be valid only if made in writing and signed by all Parties.

Article 8 – Governing Law and Jurisdiction:

This Contract shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the United States and the applicable state law decided upon by the Parties. The Parties consent to the exclusive jurisdiction of the federal and state courts located in the agreed venue for resolving any disputes arising under this Contract.

Article 9 – Severability:

If any provision of this Contract is held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect, and the invalid provision shall be altered and interpreted to best accomplish the objectives of the original provision within the limits of applicable law.

Article 10 – Entire Agreement:

This Contract constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties and supersedes all prior or contemporaneous understandings, communications, and agreements, whether oral or written, regarding the subject matter hereof.
