

STANDARD EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT

Employer:

Employee:

1. Position and Duties

Employer agrees to employ Employee as [Position Title]. Employee shall perform the duties and responsibilities customary to such position and as assigned by Employer. Employee agrees to devote full working time and attention to the performance of these duties in a diligent and competent manner.

2. At-Will Employment

Employment with Employer is at-will, which means that either Employer or Employee may terminate the employment relationship at any time, with or without cause or advance notice, subject to applicable laws.

3. Compensation

Employee shall be compensated at the rate of [Salary or Wage Amount] payable in accordance with Employer's regular pay schedule, subject to applicable tax and other payroll deductions as required by law.
