Clause 1 – Purpose of Agreement

This Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions under which the Parties agree to be legally married and defines their mutual rights and obligations in connection with the wedding ceremony and related services.

Clause 2 – Representations and Warranties

Each Party represents and warrants that he or she is legally eligible to marry, is of sound mind, and is entering into this Agreement voluntarily and without duress or undue influence.

Clause 3 – Wedding Services

Services to be provided include the ceremony, reception, and any additional services expressly agreed upon in writing. The Parties agree to cooperate fully to enable the service providers to perform their duties.

Clause 4 – Payment Terms

The Parties agree to pay the total contract price as described above. Deposit is non-refundable except as otherwise provided herein. The balance shall be paid on or before the balance due date by the agreed method of payment.

Clause 5 – Cancellation Policy

Either Party may cancel the Agreement upon written notice. Deposit may be retained by the service providers as liquidated damages. Cancellation fees and conditions are as per attached Schedule, incorporated herein by reference.

Clause 6 – Change Requests

Any changes to the wedding details must be agreed upon in writing by both Parties and may be subject to additional charges or fees.

Clause 7 – Liability and Indemnification

Each Party agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the other Party and all service providers from liability arising from their own negligence or willful misconduct in connection with the wedding event.

Clause 8 – Force Majeure

Neither Party shall be liable for failure or delay in performance due to causes beyond their reasonable control including acts of God, government restrictions, natural disasters, or other force majeure events.

Clause 9 – Governing Law and Dispute Resolution

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the United States and the state agreed upon by the Parties. Any disputes shall be resolved through mediation before pursuing any legal action.

Clause 10 – Entire Agreement

This Agreement, including all attached schedules and exhibits, constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties and supersedes all prior agreements, representations, and understandings.

Clause 11 – Amendments

Any amendments or modifications to this Agreement must be in writing and signed by both Parties to be effective.

Clause 12 – Severability

If any provision of this Agreement is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Clause 13 – Confidentiality

The Parties agree to keep the terms of this Agreement and any confidential information private unless disclosure is required by law or agreed in writing.
