Recitals:

WHEREAS, the Client(s) desire to engage the Officiant to conduct a wedding ceremony; and WHEREAS, the Officiant agrees to perform such services under the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement.

1. Services:

The Officiant shall perform the wedding ceremony on behalf of the Client(s) at the location and time agreed upon between the parties. This includes preparation, rehearsal attendance (if applicable), and the ceremony itself.

2. Fees and Payment:
