Payment Schedule and Method: _____

1. Services Provided

The Service Provider agrees to provide videography services as detailed herein, including filming, editing, and delivery of wedding videos as specified. The services shall be performed with due care, skill, and professionalism.

2. Client Obligations

Client shall provide necessary access to the wedding venue(s) and cooperation of individuals involved. Client is responsible for obtaining any required permissions or permits for videography.

3. Payment Terms

Client agrees to pay the total contract price as specified, including deposit and balance. Deposit is non-refundable

except as provided in this Agreement. Final payment is due prior to delivery of final videos.

4. Cancellation and Refunds

If Client cancels the service more than 30 days prior to the wedding date, the deposit shall be refunded less any non-recoverable costs. Cancellations within 30 days forfeit the deposit. Service Provider reserves the right to cancel due to unforeseen circumstances with full refund to Client.

5. Delivery of Final Product

Final edited videos will be delivered in agreed formats within the estimated timeline. Delays caused by Client or unforeseen events may affect delivery times. Client agrees to final acceptance upon delivery.

6. Intellectual Property Rights

Service Provider retains all copyright and intellectual property rights in the videography footage and edited products, granting Client a perpetual, non-exclusive license for personal use. Client shall not reproduce or distribute videos commercially without prior written consent.

7. Limitations of Liability

Service Provider's liability for any claim arising out of this Agreement is limited to the amount paid by Client. Service Provider is not liable for loss or damage beyond this amount, including consequential or incidental damages.

8. Force Majeure

Neither party shall be liable for failure to perform due to causes beyond reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, government restrictions, natural disasters, or other emergencies.

9. Governing Law; Jurisdiction

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the United States and the State where the Service Provider's principal place of business is located. Any disputes shall be resolved exclusively in the competent courts of such state.

10. Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the parties and supersedes all prior negotiations and agreements. Amendments must be made in writing and signed by both parties.

11. Indemnification

Client agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Service Provider from any claims, damages, or liabilities arising from Client's breach of this Agreement or misuse of the delivered videos.

12. Confidentiality

Both parties agree to keep confidential any proprietary information exchanged during the term of this Agreement.

13. Client Cooperation

Client agrees to cooperate fully and provide any materials or information reasonably requested by Service Provider to fulfill the services.

14. No Warranty

Service Provider makes no warranties, express or implied, regarding the suitability or merchantability of the services or final deliverables.

15. Assignment

Neither party may assign or transfer this Agreement without prior written consent of the other party.

16. Severability

If any provision is found invalid or unenforceable, the remainder shall remain in full force and effect.

17. Notices

All notices must be in writing and delivered by certified mail, email with delivery receipt, or other verifiable method to the addresses provided.

18. Amendments

Any changes to this Agreement must be in writing and signed by authorized representatives of both parties.

19. Waiver

Failure to enforce any provision shall not be deemed a waiver of future enforcement rights.

20. Signatures and Counterparts

This Agreement may be executed in counterparts and electronic signatures shall be deemed valid and binding.
